AN AVIATOR IS KILLED

WHILE COMPETING IN THE INTERNATIONAL RACE—AVIATOR ROLLS WAS KILLED AND AVIATOR AUCSMARS INJURED.

(Herald Special.)

London, July 12.—Charles Stewart Rolls, the English aviator, who recently flew across the English Channel, was killed today by a fall in his aeroplane at Bournemouth. Aviator Aucsmars fell at the same time and was seriously injured. Rolls was competing at the time of the accident. His machine collapsed and fell a distance of forty feet. The motor fell on him and he was dead when taken from the wreck. Aucsmars is expected to recover.

Rolls was the third man to cross the English Channel in an aeroplane, and was one of the three members of the English team selected to go to the United States to take part in the international balloon races which started from St. Louis last October. Rolls was flying in a Wright aeroplane when the accident befell him today. He was the third son of Lord L. L. Austreck, and had won fame as an auto driver and balloonist, having won many big auto races.

GERMANY EMPHATIC

IN ADVISING UNITED STATES THAT IT WILL DO AS IT PLEASES IN SOUTH AND CENTRAL AMERICAN AFFAIRS.

Berlin, July 12.—Germany today threw down the gauntlet to the United States in an official statement by its foreign office, declaring that Germany intends to do as it pleases in the South and Central American affairs, without any supervision from America. SIX PEOPLE ARE KILLED

AND SCORES INJURED AS RESULT OF WRECK OF SECOND SECTION OF COAST LINE FLYER NEAR GETZ, CAL., TODAY.

(Herald Special.)

Salinas, Cal., July 12.—The second section of the Coast Line Southern Pacific passenger train was ditched near Getz this morning, and six persons are known to be dead and scores of others injured. The engineer, fireman, conductor and a woman are missing. The train was running as a special and carried many prominent eastern delegates to the Chemists' Association convention at Los Angeles. Advices received here say that the wreck occurred on a strip of track that hugs the hillsides of the Salinas river, and dispatches say that the engine and tender overturned and disappeared in the river. The railroad officials claim that no passengers were injured.

EXCHANGE PRISONERS

United States Will Not Surrender Porter Charlton Unless Italy Gives Up Prisoners.

Washington, D. C., July 12.—It is learned today that it is the present intention of the state department to refuse to surrender Porter Charlton, under arrest in Jersey City for wife murder in Italy. The Italian warrant and request for the extradition of Charlton is now en route to Secretary Knox, but it is stated that it will be refused unless the Italian government will surrender to this country certain Italian criminals wanted by the United States. A deadlock seems inevitable.
