STILL ANOTHER GAS COMPANY

Wants Permission to Come Into Palestine With a Gas Plant. Application Filed Today.

Instead of one additional application for a gas plant franchise before the city council this evening, there may be two, as a third company is looking into the field, button-holing our aldermen, and talking gas.

The Chicago people filed their application for a franchise this morning. These are the people who propose to give the town dollar gas. The franchise recently granted the Federal Gas Company calls for \$1.50 and \$2.00 gas.

The Herald has not learned what the third company proposes to do about it. It is announced the parties wanting a franchise for a third company hall from Houston. Out of all these applications Palestine out to be well supplied with gas—the kind that burns.

Will Build a Plant.

Mr. W. H. McGoldrick, agent for the Federal Gas Company, called on the Herald today, and authorized us to make the statement for him that his company secured the franchise for a gas plant in Palestine in good faith, reports to the contrary notwithstanding, and that the plant would be built and operated as an independent concern, and not as an annex to any other light or fuel plant. He says his company is able to make good and will do so, and will give the people of the city what they want.

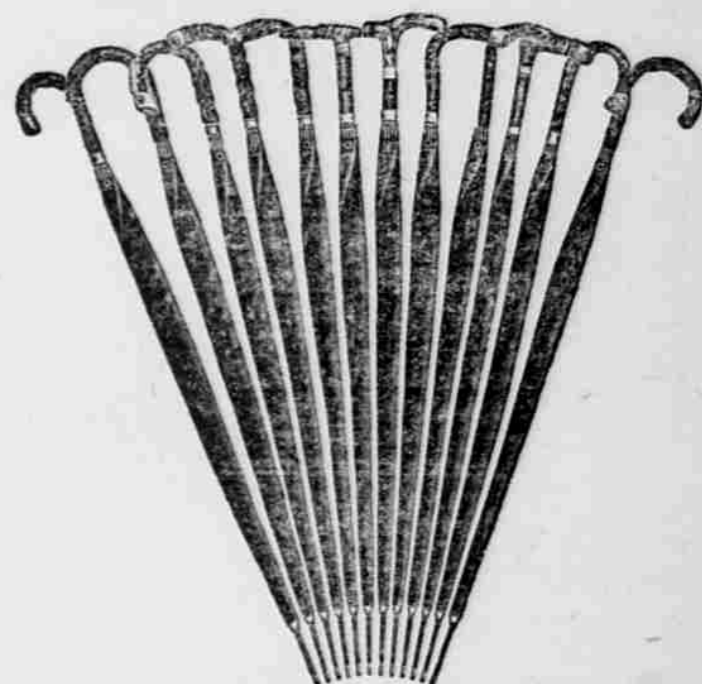
Band Concert.
