LEGAL NOTICES.

ABOUT POLL TAX.

November 16th, 1905.
D. M. Barrett, Tax Collector,
Palestine, Texas.

Dear Sir.—We are in receipt of yours of 15th instant in which you ask the following question: "Can I legally issue a poll tax receipt on written authority of the tax payer, residing in a city incorporated under the law, but shown by the last city census to contain more than 10,000 inhabitants, save and except upon the presentation of such an order as is prescribed by section 25 of the election law?"

You are respectfully advised that if the party is a resident of a city of 10,000 inhabitants his poll tax must be paid by him in person, except when conditions exist, as are prescribed in section 25 of the Terrell election law. That is, if the person intends to leave the precinct of his residence before the first day of October, with the intention not to return until after the first day of February, and does not return before that time, he can pay his poll tax through an agent, authorized by him in writing, which shall state truly his intention to depart from the precinct, his expected period of absence, and every fact necessary to enable the Tax Collector to fill the blanks on his receipts. Such authority must be sworn to.

There is no rule prescribed by the law by which it shall be determined as to whether the city contains 10,000 inhabitants or not. The population of the city has reference to the time when the poll tax is to be paid and not to the time when the party becomes subject thereto. Therefore, if the last census of the city shows it to contain 10,000 inhabitants, or more, you should be governed in the issuance of poll tax receipts to residents of said city by the provisions of the Terrell election law regulating the payment of poll taxes in cities of 10,000 inhabitants, or more.

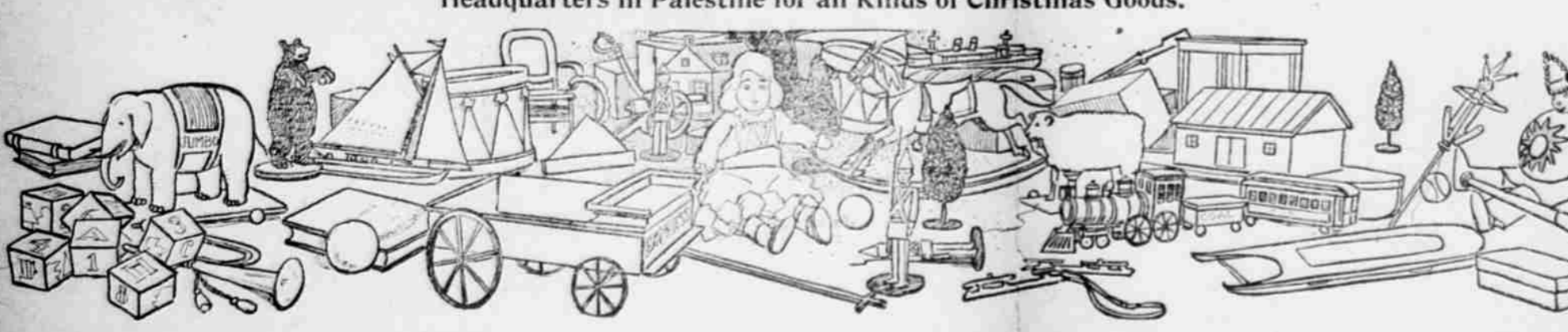
