Savannah, Ga., Nov. 17.—Savannah is preparing for a great day next Tuesday, when the Oglethorpe monument erected in Chippewa square will be unveiled with elaborate exercises. Prominent speakers will deliver addresses and there will be an imposing parade of soldiers and sailors of the United States army and navy and practically the entire National Guard of Georgia. The monument cost \$28,000, contributed chiefly by the state of Georgia and city of Savannah. It consists of a handsome marble base surmounted by a bronze statue of the founder of Georgia. The statue was designed by Daniel French.

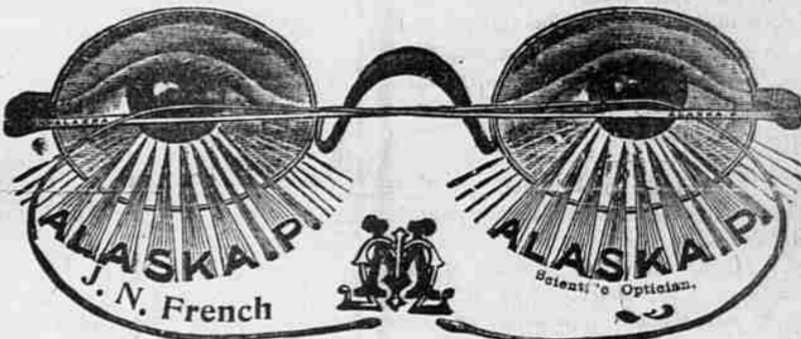
