STREET VENDORS REMOVED

Council Orders Them to Discontinue Business on Streets.

At a meeting of the city council the merchants of the city presented a petition asking the enforcement of Article 1, Chapter 46, which forbids the use of the public square, streets and alleys by street vendors for the sale of their wares. The petition of the merchants was granted. This act of the council means that the vendors of apples, bananas, spectacles and other wares must vacate their stands on the streets and public square. It is understood that the action of the council will be contested. Some of the vendors who were most affected by the order have engaged counsel and will take the matter into court.

On motion the city marshal was instructed to post signs on the bridges within the city limits prohibiting fast driving across same.

The mayor was instructed to invite the Daughters of the Confederacy to hold their next annual convention here.

Salaries of all elective officers were fixed for the next year. The mayor's salary was raised from \$25 to \$50 per month and the salaries of the alderman, city marshal and city secretary were left as they are at present.

A resolution was passed instructing property owners on Water street and East University avenue to construct sidewalks in front of their premises.

The city marshal was instructed to request the trustees of the Masonic temple to fix the sidewalk on the north side of the building.

After hearing the reports of officers and committees and allowing the accounts for the month the council adjourned.
