A RUSSIAN CRUISER IS BLOWN UP

Struck a Submarine Mine in the Harbor at Port Arthur Last Saturday.

St. Petersburg, February 16.—News has reached here of the destruction of the Russian cruiser Bavarar last Saturday in the harbor at Port Arthur. The cruiser struck a mine in the same manner as did the transport Yenise. The vessel was totally wrecked by the explosion and 157 men and officers are all reported lost.

GERMAN CRUISER FIRED UPON.

St. Petersburg, February 16.—A telegram dated at the headquarters of Viceroy Alexioff in Port Arthur says: The German cruiser Hansa which was sent to remove German subjects from Port Arthur was fired upon by Japanese warships. The German cruiser had on board a large number of Russian women and children.
