

We published a day or two since, a statement from the President of the Board, giving an account of the last moments of Col. Arr Burr, and showing that he passed from Time into Eternity without any exhibition of concern as to his future state.

In the summer, about the 20th June, 1836, Col. A. Burr came to Port Richmond House, (Staten Island), where he took board, near which I then resided, as also did the relative and friend of Col. Burr, Judge Ogden Edwards.

Accordingly from that time until the 13th September, 1836, the day on which he died at the said Port Richmond House, I visited him as a minister of the Gospel of the New Testament.

When I reminded him of the advantages he had enjoyed, of his honored and pious ancestors, viz: his father, a minister of the gospel and President of the College at Princeton, N. J., and his mother a descendant of the learned and celebrated divine, Jonathan Edwards, and that doubtless many prayers had gone up to heaven from the hearts of his parents for his well-being and happiness, it seemed to affect him; and when I asked him as to his views of the Holy Scriptures, he responded "they were the most perfect system of truth the world ever saw."
