Reporter—Mr. Stewart, THE DALLAS HERALD would be pleased for you to give your views about the probability of obtaining deep water at Sabine Pass. This is in your country, is it not?

Colonel Stewart—I am always willing to talk about Sabine Pass. Deep water can be obtained at that point for less money than at any other place on the Gulf coast.
