NEW CURE FOR RHEUMATISM.

Wonderful Results from Hot Air Experiments in Philadelphia.

Remarkable results have been obtained from a new method of treating rheumatic affections which has just been tried in this city before the county medical society.

The method consists in the local application of hot air to the parts affected. The apparatus by which this is accomplished consists of a copper cylinder, under which several gas jets are kept burning.

Two patients were brought in for the experiment. One was a man who had been under the care of a physician, who was present, for several months, and had been gradually growing worse.

In the discussion which followed it was stated by the exhibitor that these men would probably be better in the morning than they appeared to be when the experiment closed, and that in most cases one application is sufficient.

It is recorded that an eagle kept in confinement has been known to fast for three weeks, those who have had charge of it having forgotten to provide the usual supply of food.
