

TO PUSH WORK ON MAIN TUNNEL

Bonnie Mining Company Elects Officers; 85 Mine Works 150 Men.

Lordsburg, N. M., Jan. 12.—About February 1 work will be commenced on driving the main tunnel of the mines of the Monte Rico Mining and Milling Company at Lee's peak, by machinery, in an effort to open up the ore bodies and commence shipments.

At the annual meeting of the Bonnie Mining company, A. J. Allen of Chicago, Ill., was re-elected president and J. B. Foster, secretary and treasurer.

At the 300 foot level of the new shaft a drift will be made connecting with the No. 3 shaft and exploration of intermediate ground will take place.

One hundred and fifty men are now given employment at the "85" mine, being a doubling of the working force.

SELLS GOLD ORE AT CUT PRICES

Mysterious Stranger Puzzles Prescott; Almost Gives Gold Away.

Prescott, Ariz., Jan. 12.—After selling 15 or 20 samples of gold ore running above \$100,000 to the town a mysterious stranger, dressed in the rough garb of a prospector and badly in need of a shave, dropped out of sight.

Some of those who purchased samples from him had the ore run through an assay apparatus. Nearly all recovered gold worth fully twice as much as they paid the stranger.




