ULTIMATUM TO HUNGARY ASSERTS 250,000 BUDAPEST WORKMEN AWAIT DEPARTURE OF ROMANIANS TO SEIZE POWER AND RESTORE BOLSHIEVISM; ENTENTE DISTUSTED; ANGLO-AMERICAN DOMINATION OF RUMANIA SOUGHT, CHARGE.

VIENNA, Austria, Aug. 14.—(By the Associated Press.)—A statement attacking England and America, demanding that Hungary be united with Rumania under king Ferdinand, and threatening to strip Hungary if the Rumanian army is forced to withdraw from that country, has been presented to archduke Joseph, head of the Hungarian government, by the authorized Rumanian representative at Budapest, according to dispatches received here.
