A DEED OF TRUST FILED BY J. S. PERRY OF THE CHICAGO STORE.

Amount Due Creditors About \$31,000. Ivan S. Terrill Appointed Trustee and Takes Charge of the Stock. May Soon Be Revived.

Yesterday morning J. S. Perry, manager of the Chicago store, 609 and 611 Houston street, filed a deed of trust in the county clerk's office upon the entire stock, consisting of merchandise, chinaware, fancy goods, dry goods, clothing, cutlery, books, furniture, fixtures, etc.; also seventy shares of the capital stock of the Home Investment association, value \$1000, and a life insurance policy, value about \$7500.

Ivan S. Terrill was appointed trustee and has taken charge of the stock. Mr. Perry has large property in other states, which will not be affected by this embroilment, and as he is an energetic and capable business man, and well estimated here, all will be glad to know that he expects to reassume his business here at an early date.
