At 57 5-8c and 58 1-8c a good deal of short wheat was covered, and a large quantity was for sale. The market began weaker again about an hour from the close, and 57 1-8c became the general trading price for some time, with sales at 56 7-8c, and at those prices a vast amount changed hands. Spot sellers had by this time diminished all feeling for each other and in another half hour prices were 56 1-8c. The decline continued up to the close; the selling became more and more urgent as the session advanced. May reacted but 1-8c from the lowest figures of the day, finishing at 56 7-8c.
