ABOUT TOWN.

The Knights of Honor hold their regular meeting tonight.

The district court party will probably come down from Hidalgo this afternoon, as court was expected to adjourn there today.

The body of the unfortunate suicide, Sabas Hernandez, has not been found. As it is now over a week since he was drowned, it does not seem probable that the remains will ever be recovered.

The Sol de Mayo reports the death, in Matamoros Saturday last, of a coachman named Mariano Escamilla, at the age of 125 years. The remains were buried in the family cemetery at the Longoreño ranch.

FIVE DEATHS INVOLVED.

A Murderer Who Was Finally Killed Himself.

Guadalajara, Mex., Oct. 4.—Jose Hernandez some time ago committed a double-murder here, one of his victims being his own brother. He escaped, went to the City of Mexico and got a position on the police force. A few days ago it was discovered that he was a criminal wanted here, and two detectives were dispatched to this city having him in charge. While en route Hernandez escaped. The next act in this drama was Hernandez appearing on a neighborhood hacienda, where he told a pitiful story, that he was a poor peddler and had been robbed and maltreated on the public highway. The owner of the hacienda aided him and gave him a horse and the escort of the servant to go to this city. On the way Hernandez killed the servant, and while leading the man's horse was overtaken by a posse and a fierce fight ensued. Hernandez opened fire and killed one of his pursuers and fatally wounded another. Finally he was himself killed. Thus this drama of crime involves the death of five persons.

By Cable to Asia.

American commercial enterprise keeps within range of American political expansion and governmental initiative. Already several new steamer routes have been projected to follow the progress of the flag westward across the Pacific. A submarine cable, it is now promised, is soon to add another and more intimate link between the California shore and Hawaii and the Philippines, there to join the cables that run to Japan and to the mainland at Hongkong. The company which intends to push the enterprise was incorporated at Albany a few days ago, and its serious character is indicated by the appearance among its incorporators of John W. Mackay, one of the owners of one of the Atlantic cables. He promises that the work will be completed nine months after the landing permits shall have been granted by this Government.

That Mexican Jetty.

The fact is noted by some of our observant ones that our neighbors across the Rio Grande are continuing to work on the breakwater they began to build along the river front opposite Brownsville some years ago, and from indications are preparing to extend it far up the river. It may be that this work may have no bad effect upon this side of the river, but there are those who attribute the continued encroachment of the stream on this side below the ferry to the building of this levee, and it is urged by them that if the construction of such a levee is allowable on the other side, we should also be privileged to resort to similar means in order to protect this side from further encroachment. If THE HERALD is not mistaken, it was agreed by the International Boundary Commission, on its visit to Brownsville several years ago, that no more work of the kind should be done at this point, but it may be that the agreement was only temporary. However, that may be, it would seem incumbent upon our citizens to investigate the matter, and see if measures cannot be taken to protect the bank on this side. Let us not sleep on our rights.
