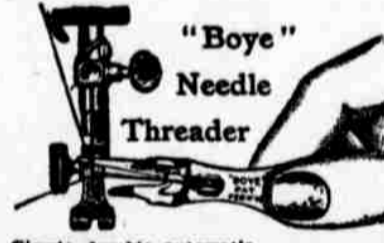

Box Elder County FAIR.

The Big Four County Fair will be held in Ogden, Utah, this year on September 30th, October 1st, 2nd and 3rd. This Fair is the official fair of Box Elder County, so recognized by resolutions by the County Commissioners of Box Elder County.

The Inter-Mountain Fair Association of Ogden owns the Ogden Fair Grounds and started the fair, but later on changed the name to the Big Four County Fair and admitted Box Elder, Morgan and Duvis Counties, who, with Weber County, make the Big Four counties. Next year, it is proposed to hold the Fair in Brigham City. The County Commissioners, Fruit Tree Inspectors and Mayors of each county form the county board of Control.
