WINTER TERM OPENS.

The Agricultural college at Logan has inaugurated its courses for the winter season, and the list includes dairying, forestry, sugar beet growing, irrigation, road construction, domestic science and arts, and commerce, the terms in these subjects running from January 5th to late in February. The annual state farmers' round-up commenced on January 11th, and will continue two weeks, the first week being devoted to live stock and the second to fruit raising and farm crops. A very large attendance is reported so far during the course. The corps of instructors for the round-up is unusually large this year, and includes men of state and national reputation. The courses for the winter term have evidently been very carefully arranged with respect to the needs of the state, and exceptional advantages are offered by the college this year.

The Salt Lake Choral Society held a rehearsal Sunday evening on the "Elijah" and the soloists were announced to the society. Contrary to the first intention the singers are all local people. Nine soloists in all are required as the oratorio is to be given in two parts. The soloists for the first part are: Mrs. Anna Colborn Plummer, soprano; Miss Edna Dwyer, contralto; Mr. M. J. Brines, tenor, and Mr. Horace S. Ensign, baritone. For the second part the soloists will be: Mrs. Emma Ramsey Morris, soprano; Miss Hazel Barnes, contralto; Mr. Fred C. Graham, tenor, and Mr. Hugh W. Dougall, baritone. There is also a special soprano part, that of the youth and Miss Edna Evans has been secured to sing it.

The orchestra of fifty pieces has been engaged and consists mainly of members of the Salt Lake Symphony Orchestra.

Richard Carle is heard from again. He will open May 30th, at the Colonial in Chicago, in "The Hurdy-Gurdy Girl." He will appear in "The Boy and the Girl," in Boston, next summer.

Mrs. Leslie Carter opened her season at Washington last week, and she will shortly occupy the Liberty Theater, in New York, following the big melodramatic success, "Via Wireless."
