There is \$150,000 more or less coming next week to shareholders in the various Colorado vein companies and at current quotations on their stocks a share in that \$150,000 is about the easiest money that can be picked up in this part of the reservation.

#### MANY THOROUGHBREDS COMING.

Within the week that has passed since the announcement that the Utah Jockey club had secured the mile track across the river, and that contractors were busy preparing the place for the meeting, Manager W. W. Finn has received a flood of letters and telegrams from horsemen announcing that they will bring their strings here as soon as arrangements can be made, and it is expected that the first arrivals will be here within a week.

Arrangements have been made to temporarily stable all early arrivals at Agricultural Park, awaiting the completion of the stables at the new track. All of the best horses now in the west and northwest will be here, and a number of eastern owners bringing horses to the Denver meeting will ship them here.

Beginning September 18th, and lasting thirty days, the meet will not interfere with any bush meeting in nearby towns, and this will assure the presence of many who otherwise might be tempted to attend elsewhere.

A party of local men who are interested in the coming meet though not members of the Utah Jockey club, went out on a tour of inspection on Tuesday and upon their return expressed themselves as greatly pleased with the track.
