An ordinance levying a tax and for the assessment of property on the west side of Thirteenth East Street between First South and Second South Streets; side of Thirteenth East Street between First South and Second South Streets; in Paving District No. 27, for the purpone of providing for the grading, guttering and curbing thereso.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Sait Lake City, Utah:

SECTION I. That the City Council does hereby levy the tax and provide for the assessment of the same upon the property hereinafter described in Paving District No. 27, for the grading, curbing and guttering of a certain street therein, to-wit:

In Lots Nos. 1 and 18 to 23, inclusive, East Side Subdivision, Block 31, Plat Tr. abutting on the west side of Thirteenth East Street 'tween First South and Second South streets.
