This is one of the characteristics of his great success to Shakespeare's "Merchant of Venice."

After perusing the above, we sincerely hope that Mr. De Grasse will not overlook Salt Lake in his itinerary the coming season, for now that the Shuberts have announced that they will skip our beautiful city, we think we will be slighted indeed if this great star overlooks us.
