An ordinance levying a tax and for the assessment of property on both sides of all north and south streets from the south side of South Temple Street to the north side of Third South Street, from Second East Street to Tenth East Street, both streets inclusive, in Paving Districts Nos. 27 and 28, for the purpose of providing for the curbing and guttering thereof.

Be it ordained by the City Council of

SECTION 1. That the City Council does hereby levy the tax and provide for the assessment of the same upon the property hreinafter described in Paving Districts Nos. 27 and 28, for the curbing and guttering of certain streets therein, to-wit:

In Lots 1 and 8, Block 57; 1, 6, 7 and 8, Block 56, Plat "B." 2, 3, 4 and 5, Block 36; and 4 and 5, Block 29, Plat "F," abutting on both sides of Tenth East Street between South Temple and Second South Streets.

This tax is levied to defray the expense of curbing and guttering the portions of said street opposite the
