AN ORDINANCE.

An ordinance levying a tax and for
the assessment of property on both
sides of all north and south streets
from the south side of South Temple
Street to the north side of Third South
Street, from Second East Street to
Tenth East Street, both streets inclu-
sive, in Paving Districts Nos. 27 and
28, for the purpose of providing for
the curbing and guttering thereof.

Be it ordained by the City Council of
Salt Lake City, Utah:

SECTION 1. That the City Council
does hereby levy the tax and provide
for the assessment of the same upon
the property hereinafter described in
Paving Districts Nos. 27 and 28, for
the curbing and guttering of certain
streets therein, to-wit:

In Lots 1 and 8, Block 57; 1, 6, 7 and
8, Block 56, Plat "B;" 2, 3, 4 and 5,
Block 36; and 4 and 5, Block 29, Plat
"F," abutting on both sides of Tenth
East Street between South Temple and
Second South Streets.

This tax is levied to defray the ex-
pense of curbing and guttering the
portions of said street opposite the

property hereinafter and hereinafter
described to be especially affected and
benefited by said improvement, and it
is hereby adjudged, determined and es-
tablished that said property will be es-
pecially benefited thereby to the full
amount of the tax hereby levied, and
said parcels of land are hereby as-
sessed at an equal and uniform rate
in accordance with the linear foot
frontage upon said portions of said
streets fronting upon and to a depth
of twenty-five (25) feet back there-
from, and the tax hereby levied and to
be assessed upon said parcels of land
is three thousand five hundred sixty-
one and 25-100 (\$3,561.25) dollars, or
one and 3,489,584-10,000,000 (\$1,3,489,-
584) dollars per front or linear foot of
abutting property for curbing and gut-
tering said portions of the street above
mentioned in Paving Districts Nos. 27
and 28, there being 2640 feet of abut-
ting property within the boundaries of
the lots, blocks and street above men-
tioned, which is the total cost and cost
per front foot of said curbing and gut-
tering according to the contract en-
tered into for the performance of said
work and making said improvement
with J. D. Hanley, dated the 14th day
of September, 1908, and the Treasurer
is hereby authorized and directed to as-
sess in accordance with the provisions
of this ordinance for the purpose here-
in mentioned:

Fronting on Tenth East Street:

The east side of Lots 1 and 8, Block
57; the east side of Lots 1, 6, 7 and 8,
Block 56, Plat "B;" the west side of
Lots 2, 3, 4 and 5, Block 36; and the
west side of Lots 4 and 5, Block 29,
Plat "F," Salt Lake City Survey, as
the same are shown upon the official
plats of said city to a depth of twenty-
five (25) feet back from said street,
and to collect said tax.

SECTION 2. Said tax shall become
and be delinquent in five equal install-
ments, as follows, to-wit: One-fifth
thereof one year after the approval of
the ordinance confirming the levy of
the tax for the payment for such im-
provement; one-fifth thereof in two
years after such approval; one-fifth
thereof in three years after such ap-
proval; one-fifth thereof in four years
after such approval; and one-fifth
thereof in five years after such ap-
proval. One or more of said install-
ments, or the whole tax may be paid
on or before ten days after the ap-
proval of the ordinance confirming the
levy of the tax. One or more install-
ments, or the whole special tax may be
paid on the day any installment be-
comes due by paying the amount there-

of and interest to date of payment.
Each of said installments shall bear in-
terest at the rate of six (6) per cent
per annum from the date of the ap-
proval of the ordinance confirming the
levy of said tax until date of delin-
quency, and eight (8) per cent per an-
num from delinquency until paid.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall
take effect upon approval.

Passed by the City Council of Salt
Lake City, Utah, August 16th, 1909, and
referred to the Mayor for his approval.
