

HUERTA IS READY TO LEAVE MEXICO

Veracruz, June 30.—The departure of the French cruiser Conde for Puerto Mexico and the sailing of the German cruiser Dresden, presumably for the same port, gave rise to the suggestion here today that President Huerta's family and perhaps himself would be afforded refuge on one of the warships.

Several weeks ago a room was prepared on the Conde for someone who never arrived and it was current gossip that President Huerta was to occupy the quarters.

Washington, June 30.—With the Mexican mediation conference at Niagara Falls on the eve of a recess pending the proposed meeting of representatives of General Huerta and the constitutionalists to discuss the internal affairs of their republic...

Carranza representatives, who had expected earlier in the day that some definite reply might be received by night, announced later that nothing would be learned until tomorrow at the earliest.

Reason for Delay. In some quarters the feeling is persistent that the constitutionalists will delay replying to the invitation of the mediators to participate in a conference with Huerta's delegates as long as possible in order to gain time for straightening out their own internal affairs...

Fears of Uprising. Considerable apprehension was created in official quarters over an unofficial report communicated to the state department that General Huerta had begun to get his family near the eastern coast of Mexico by sending two of his children toward Veracruz.

This led to reports that he was preparing to flee from Mexico in order to save himself and family from falling into the hands of the constitutionalists.

CHAMP CLARK IS GIVEN PRAISE

Washington, June 30.—Speaker Clark had an automobile thrust on him today by the house of representatives against his wishes, but he will accept it and ride in it.

During his temporary absence, the house, by a vote of 128 to 120, voted concurrence in the senate amendment to the legislative appropriation bill authorizing the purchase of automobiles for both the speaker and the vice president.

The bill was then returned to conference because the house would not agree to strike from it the amendment reducing members and senators mileage allowance from 20 cents per mile of travel to 5 cents a mile coming to and returning to their homes for attendance at sessions of congress.

Republican Leader Mann, urging the automobile for the speaker, said: "Two years ago, about this time, there was a gathering over at Baltimore, the advance guard of the Democratic national convention. 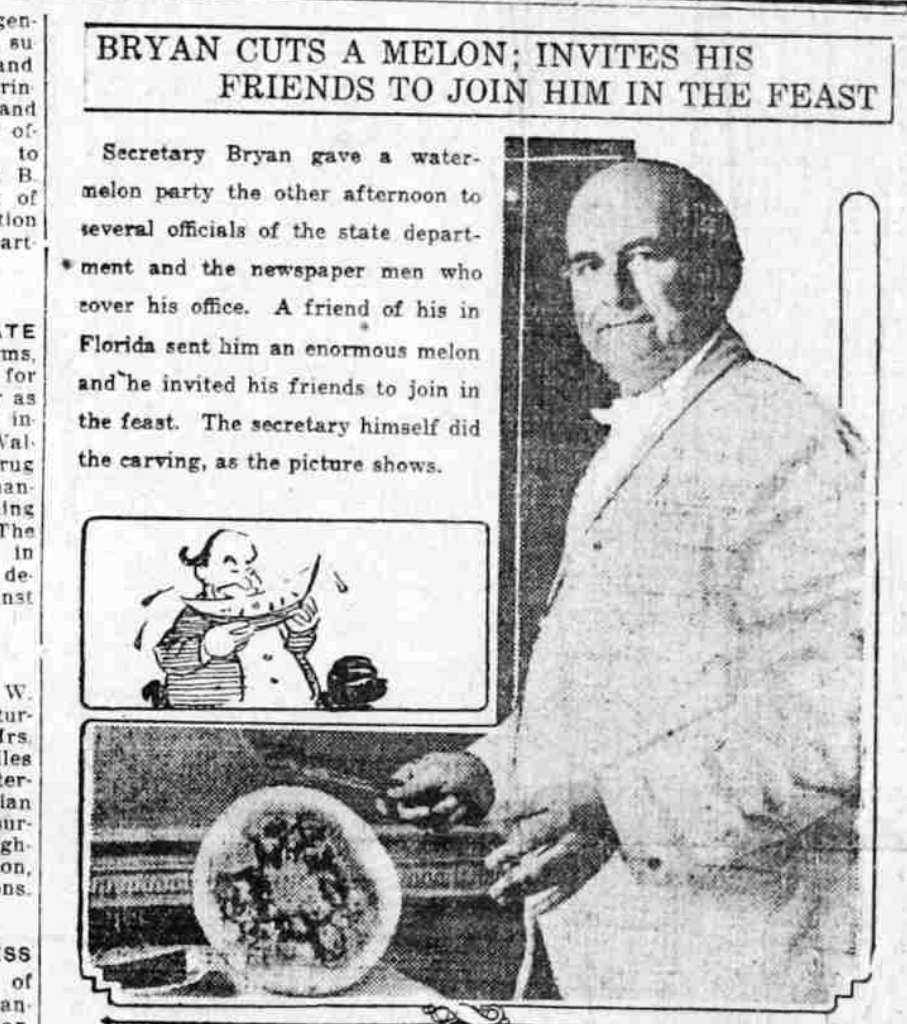
