CITY RAILWAY HAS HEAVY DEFICIT

Seattle, Wash., July 14.—The deficit in the operation of the Seattle municipal railway system, consisting of two separate lines five and eight miles long, respectively, running through sparsely settled districts, will be \$36,397 for the coming year, according to an estimate by A. L. Valentine, superintendent of public utilities published here today.

Mr. Valentine estimates the gross revenues for the coming year at \$36,000 and the total expenditure, including \$13,500 interest on bonds, at \$72,397.
