

First—Use a small, dry and thoroughly clean porcelain teapot. Second—Put in one teaspoonful of tea leaves for each cup of tea desired. Third—When using Japanese tea, pour on the required quantity of fresh boiling water, and let stand with closed lid from 2 to 3 minutes.
