## TOOLEE SMELTER IS NEARING COMPLETION

International People Are Exerting Every Effort to Finish Plant.

Report from the new international smelting plant at Toolee is to the effect that the big smelting, one of the largest in this western country, has been completed, and that work along all lines of smelter construction is going ahead rapidly. The stack just finished is some 350 feet in height, and is constructed to carry off satisfactorily the smoke and fumes resulting from the smelting processes.

Now that the weather has moderated to a great extent, it is stated that the international people contemplate increasing their working force, in order that the plant may be ready to completion.

The management has quite recently issued a statement to the effect that as per contract the smelter would be ready to receive the ore of the Utah Consolidated property as per contract, on April 1, and though during the winter months operations were with difficulty carried on, a wonderful showing has been made.

Some 600 men have been on the company's pay roll in the building work for many months, and where delay has been experienced in one particular branch of the construction, the crews have been placed elsewhere in accomplishing some other part of the work.

It is stated that the steel for the big plant is due to arrive at its destination in the middle of the month; machinery is arriving and being placed rapidly, and everything considered conditions at the smelter are very satisfactory.
