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Farm Demonstrator for Wise County

We have received from the Federated Civic League the communication published below. We heartily concur in the movement to employ a competent Farm Demonstrator for the county. Indeed we cannot conceive how the Board of Supervisors, after experiencing the benefits which followed from Mr. Styles' administration, ever permitted the county to be without such valuable service.

Let the Board employ a man at once, it will be the best money that can be expended for all the people:

The Federated Civic League of Wise County, realizing the serious food situation confronting Wise county, issue this call to every progressive citizen in the county to join in the big drive to secure a farm demonstrator organizer for our county, and join in a movement that will insure the greatest efficiency of every citizen. Every progressive citizen is called upon to write the county supervisors urging immediate action, and pledging the Supervisors the fullest co-operation in this, our country's greatest crisis. The assurance that next year the food problem will be more serious than this year, and it is highly important that something be done to organize our forces on a war basis, and insure the greatest possible results from the soil in Wise county.

Mr. R. L. McLemore, President of the Wise County Fair Association, states that it is absolutely essential that Wise county have a farm demonstrator, one who can organize and mobilize her greatest co-operation. Mr. McLemore also states that if every progressive citizen in the county would join in backing up the Supervisors that it would insure the county's having a farm demonstrator organizer immediately and get well organized for next years work.

The Wise County Fair Association has agreed to put up fifty dollars for publicity and agitation purposes to wake up the progressive citizens to the serious food situation.

The Federated League hopes that every firm in the county will donate to the publicity and educational fund.

Every man woman and child is vitally interested in the success of the Liberty Bond sales. The saving of the lives of thousands of our soldiers by the speedy ending of the war is one of the results hoped for, in which we will all rejoice. The Germans are watching closely what we are doing. We have quickly mobilized a large army and sent several hundred thousand men to France—have over subscribed the first loan called for, much to their surprise and dismay, and when we largely over subscribe the largest loan ever called for by any nation in the world we will complete their discomfort, which will soon be followed by their raising the white flag of peace, probably before our armies become actively engaged in the war. Behind these bonds stand the entire wealth of the United States and they are better than

a national bank note. Nearly everyone can subscribe for the bonds, as the banks of the county, after the payment of the first two installments will carry the bonds for you as long as you want them to do so, provision having been made to that effect by all the banks of the County, State and National. To buy a \$50 bond will require you to pay on subscription 2 per cent. or \$1.00. After that \$9.00, and then you can carry the balance as a loan. Every man and woman should subscribe to the loan and take part in the great movement to provide for our soldiers and shatter the German hope that we would prosecute the war in a half hearted way. Let us all work, work incessantly until the loan is greatly over subscribed.
