Georgians Held For Slave Keeping. Macon, Ga., June 20.—William V. Sly, Robert F. Turner and Arthur Glasgow, farmers of Jasper county, were arraigned before a United States commission on a warrant issued by the United States court charging them with forcibly deporting William Walters, a negro farm hand, from a plantation in Jones county to Jasper, whipping and otherwise mistreating him. The three defendants were held in \$1,000 bail to answer. Each gave bond.

Prominent Railroad Man Dead. Meriden, Conn., June 20.—William Lyman Squires, treasurer of the New York, New Haven and Hartford Railway company, has died at his residence here after a lingering illness. He was seventy-two years old.

Assaulted an Emperor's Son. Delaware, O., June 20.—Charles Needham, attorney for the Korean legation at Washington, has been here and has investigated the recent assault by Joseph Stout, a young farmer, upon Prince Eulwha, son of the emperor of Korea, who is a student at Delaware. Stout has been arrested and is bound over until the next term of court in September.
