

THREE LARGE GRAVES

Affidavits of the Surviving Americans Show Criticism of Use of the Lusitania's Boats, but Do Not Reflect Seriously on Behavior of the Crew

Kinsale, Ireland, May 10, 3:27 p. m.—The coroner's jury, which has been investigating the deaths attendant upon the loss of the Lusitania, returned the following verdict to-day:

QUEENSTOWN, VIA LONDON, MAY 10.

The affidavits made by Miss Jessie Taft Smith of Braintree, O., Dr. Howard L. Fisher, Major F. Warren Pearl and Robert Rankin of New York are the only permanent records of the Lusitania disaster obtained by the United States consulate to-day. All are brief and none reflect seriously upon the behavior of the Lusitania's crew, except what some witnesses consider the lifeboat fiasco.
