NOT DECIDED YET.

The Presidential Election Hinges on the Vote of New York.

The Official Count now in Progress in that State, with the Returns Showing an Apparent Plurality for Mr. Cleveland of 10,000 Votes.

The changes which have taken place since last week with regard to the result of the presidential election can be summed up in a few words. The states of Florida, Indiana, Nevada, Virginia and West Virginia, which were put down a week ago as doubtful, are conceded to have been carried by the Democrats...

Both sides have engaged all eyes to the contest of the vote of New York. In New York City Mr. M. E. Conover and Dr. Bliss are leading counts for the Republicans, while Roscoe Conkling acts as chief adviser for the Democrats.

The official count began in the several counties according to law last Tuesday. Up to Wednesday night the count had been completed in 49 of the 60 counties in the state. The official returns vary but little from the returns gathered by the newspapers.

It is stated that Col. George Bliss expects to take exception to about 1000 votes which were defective or cast for H. C. St. John and counted for Cleveland. In this 1000 are included some 2000 Republican votes said to have been thrown out because a part of his name of one of the electors was clipped off.
