

TEUTONS GAIN YARD BY YARD ON VERDUN

They Secured a Footing in Two Small Field Works Between Haucourt and Hill No. 287, the French War Office Admits, After Night Attacks

GRENADE ATTACK NEAR VAUX FAILED

Between Bethincourt and Chattanooga, the French Claim That the Grenade Fighting Turned to Their Advantage—Intermittent Bombardment to East of Meuse

Paris, April 8.—The Germans renewed their attacks on Haucourt in the Verdun region last night and gained a footing in two small field works between Haucourt and Hill No. 287, the war office announced today. The fighting with grenades between Bethincourt and Chattanooga turned to the advantage of the French.

Progress in German communicating trenches southeast of Bethincourt was announced by the French last night. The official report was as follows: "In Belgium our heavy artillery has carried out a destructive fire on German organizations at Middelkerke and Lange-maek.

West of the Meuse, after a violent bombardment, lasting several hours, the enemy directed against our positions to the south and on the eastern outskirts of the village of Haucourt a strong attack on a front of about two kilometers. "Stopped by our curtain of fire and the intense fire of our mitrailleuses, the Germans were unable to reach their goal and were forced to retreat to their trenches, leaving on the ground numerous bodies.
