**Fate of a Party of Klondikers on the Way to Nome.**

A tragic story comes from St. Michael. A party of men on the way to Nome recently found the bodies of six men at a point near Cape Komandor. One of the dead men had been bitten on the neck, arm, or leg, and he lay on a litter composed of a pair of oars and canvas sheet. It would seem that the storm must have overcome them crying him. Evidently, becoming exhausted, they had abandoned him and wandered off, each himself, to perish where found.

**Ghosts From the Hot Wave in the West.**

In Kansas City, where the mercury went up to 106, very few people were able to sleep after sunrise. One report says: "The beds burned as though the sheets had just been ironed and had not cooled off after the scorching sun." A times the air is so hot that it is almost unbearable. In the neighborhood of the Missouri river, the atmosphere around the city was so hot that the rain was looked up as it fell through space. In Missouri the rain-fall since May has been from 10 to 25 per cent of the normal, but, curiously, western Kansas, which has suffered more from droughts than any other part of the country, is comparatively well off this year. The local papers report that the temperature in some localities that afflicted the large cities. In Booneville, Mo., the thermometer went to 110 for three days in succession, and a triumphant maximum of 110 was attained, July 2. **REMARKABLE RESUSCITATION IN DROWNING CASE.**

**Under Water 25 Minutes—Towed Half a Mile—And Yet Brought to Life.**

A good many medical authorities are skeptical as to the possibility of resuscitation of drowned people, especially if they have been under water many minutes. But case is reported from Brooklyn, N.Y., which was truly remarkable. The drowned man, George Schaefer, 17 years old, and two companions got in a row boat Tuesday night and went about a half mile from the foot of Thirty-fifth street to bath. They dived several times and finally Schaefer did not come up. His companions waited a few seconds and then one of them, Watson, dived for him. He did this four times without finding Schaefer. The fifth time, he brought up his body. Apparently Schaefer was dead and the boys tied a rope around the body and towed it ashore. Schaefer had been in the water so long and his body was so evidently lifeless that they didn't even hurry. It was a half hour or more to the coast. When they reached it the boys were in doubt whether to leave the body in the water and await the action of the coroner or to put it on the deck. While they were discussing what to do Dr. G. K. Barney of 404 Third street, Brooklyn, came up in his steam launch, Alma. Dr. Barney said that at first he didn't see any signs of life and had made up his mind that Schaefer was dead, when he noticed a quiver of the eyelid. The doctor then made the boys carry the body to the deck where he began to work over it, though it seemed a hopeless job. The doctor and the two boys rolled Schaefer on a barrel, worked his eyes, breathed into his mouth and bathed him with ammonia. After nearly half an hour's work Schaefer showed signs of reviving. In another half hour he was conscious. An ambulance was called and Schaefer was taken to the Norwegian hospital where he is expected to recover.

**Phrebotomy City Unearthed.**

A prehistoric city of immense proportions, is said to have been unearthed in the Navajo Indian reservation between Durango, Col. and Framingham, N.M. The particulars of the find having been reported to the land department of the Santa Fe and Denver, Colo. A paleontologist has been sent to investigate the site, which is said to contain some 1000 separate apartments, some of them in an excellent state of preservation. Another stone castle contains 100 separate apartments. In some of the rooms inspected were found the finest wood relics of the West. They have been gathered and sent to the Smithsonian institute.
