

**Failed to Send
Flagman Back**

WESTERN MARYLAND PASSENGER TRAIN RUNS INTO REAR OF A FREIGHT.

CUMBERLAND, Dec. 6.—Western Maryland passenger train, due in Hagerstown at 7:05 a. m., ran into the rear end of an extra freight train at McCoy's Ferry, at 6:30 o'clock yesterday morning, injuring Flagman Redden Wasson, of the freight train, and Fireman Bowman, of the passenger train.

The engine and combination mail and baggage car of the passenger train were wrecked.

The caboose and a carload of coal of the freight train were derailed and the car upset. Flagman Wasson was in the caboose and injured in jumping.

The freight train was running on the passenger train's time and when it stopped at the Ferry, failed to send a flagman back. The passenger train was running about 20 miles an hour when the collision occurred. The passenger is the daily accommodation between Cumberland and Baltimore.

The wrecking crew from Hagerstown cleared the tracks. Passengers were transferred around the wreck.

Increase Salaries

BILL TO RAISE PAY OF CONGRESSMEN TO \$7,500 INTRODUCED.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 6.—Representative John Wesley Gurnea, of Tennessee, introduced a bill in the House yesterday, raising the salaries of members of Congress to \$7,500 annually, to become effective in the Sixty-first Congress, and reimbursing them for money actually spent in going to and from each session of Congress.

Meanwhile, it is not improbable that the legislative appropriation bill, which is now being prepared by the House Committee on Appropriations and will be reported this week, will contain a provision for such an increase. Such a provision would be subject to a point of order, but there is said to be a tacit understanding that such a point shall not be raised. A proportional increase would allow the Vice President and Speaker of the House each \$12,000 a year, instead of \$8,000.
