MIDSUMMER DULLNESS FEATURED
THE STOCK MARKET YESTERDAY

NEW YORK Aug. 19.—Midsummer dullness was the most characteristic feature of today's narrow and uninteresting operations in the stock market. The tone varied from irregular to heavy, the latter resulting mainly from early selling of the anarchist shares which caused sympathetic declines in other active lists. Liquidation of the coalers was accompanied by rumors that the interstate commerce commission would soon direct its energies against the coal carrying railroads, but nothing in confirmations of this materialized in the course of the day. Canadian railway shares were once more to the front, Canadian Pacific making a very substantial recovery from the weakness exhibited in the latter part of the week with consequent strength in Soo, one of its allied roads. American Tobacco repeated its erratic course of recent days. The best quotations were made in the last hour when extensive dealings in steel caused a slight advance in the stock with a general stiffening of prices elsewhere. The demand for steel shares, to be based upon legislative developments in Washington, was met by offering other stocks, and soon resulted in a general reversal with an unsettled close. Unofficial cables from abroad indicate a rise of the American bull account in London and Paris based on easier conditions across the water. Bonds were irregularly sharp in value, amounted to \$1,200,000. U. S. government bonds were unchanged on call.
