A Chance for Wheeling and Bel-

According to the Indianapolis Journal, a very important branch of industry is about to be established in this country by a company of foreign capitalists. The particulars of the movement are given as follows: Mr. August Gobert, Jr., who was the Belgian Commissioner to the Centennial Exhibition, has made a report to his Government upon the glass products exhibited. He enumerates the exhibitors and their nationalities, gives the detail of manufacture, shows wherein the Americans were deficient, and the steps they have taken to remedy their errors, and gives the statistics of the production of plate, window, ornamental and table glass in the United States. As a curious fact, he mentions that about two million francs (\$400,000) were spent by one plate glass concern alone, in unimportant experiments; an expenditure which might have been saved by a trip to Europe.

Mr. Gobert attributes the rapid growth of the glass industry in the United States to a judicious protective tariff on glass. He shows that America consumes more plate glass than any other nation, and only supplies one-fifth of her own demand, therefore he urges the capitalists of Belgium to establish plate glass factories in the United States, where all the necessary material may be had in abundance.

Any communication on the subject sent to Prof. Cox will be laid before Mr. Gobert on his arrival."
