Some obvious effort was required to sustain prices to-day above the level of Saturday and the mid-day rise was not maintained to the close.

An inspection of the list will reveal that outside of a very few cases no changes are unimportant. Some observers believed that such strength as the market has is due to the support of very powerful aggregations of capital which are interested in seeing higher prices for new securities.

There were other points of exception in the market during the day, particularly among the wheat, corn and southern railroad stocks.

There was continued activity in the bond market, the speculative and reorganization bonds being the favorites.
