CHAMPION APPLE PACKING CONTEST

Spokane, Wash., Nov. 2.—A free-for-all apple packing contest for the championship of the world has been announced as a feature of this month's National Apple Show in this city. The contest has been set for Nov. 16, just two weeks from today, and at the rate entries are coming in it promises to be an exciting affair.

Professional packers are expected from points as far distant as New York, New England and Florida, the entrants from the latter state expecting their skill in packing oranges to serve them in the apple contest.

The contestants will use the standard box, having a capacity of a little more than a Winchester bushel, and each entrant will be required to pack four boxes within forty minutes to score twenty points for speed. Each additional minute consumed will reduce the score two points.

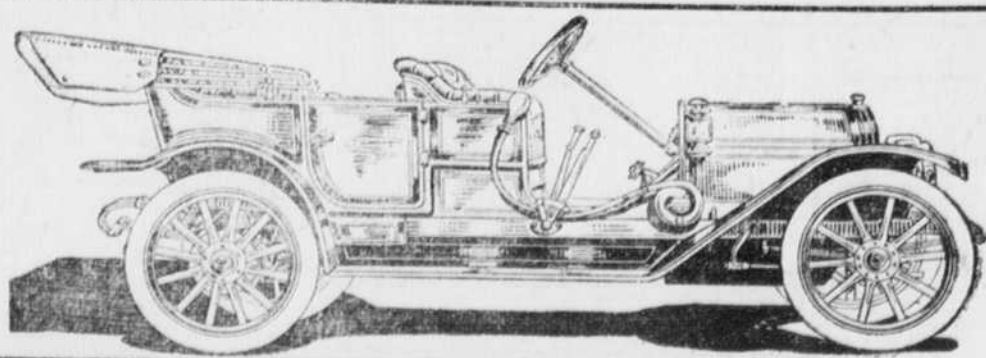

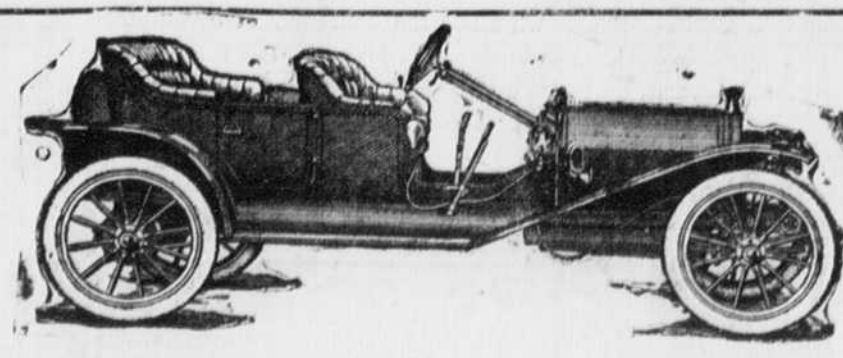
