NEW YORK, Jan. 4.—The advance in the stock market which featured the opening of the new year, was continued yesterday, with a rise in shares of almost all descriptions.

Trading was broader and more diversified than in the depressed periods of the preceding week. The rise was once more attributed to events of the last few days, which were interpreted as offering little hope for the success of the peace negotiations.
