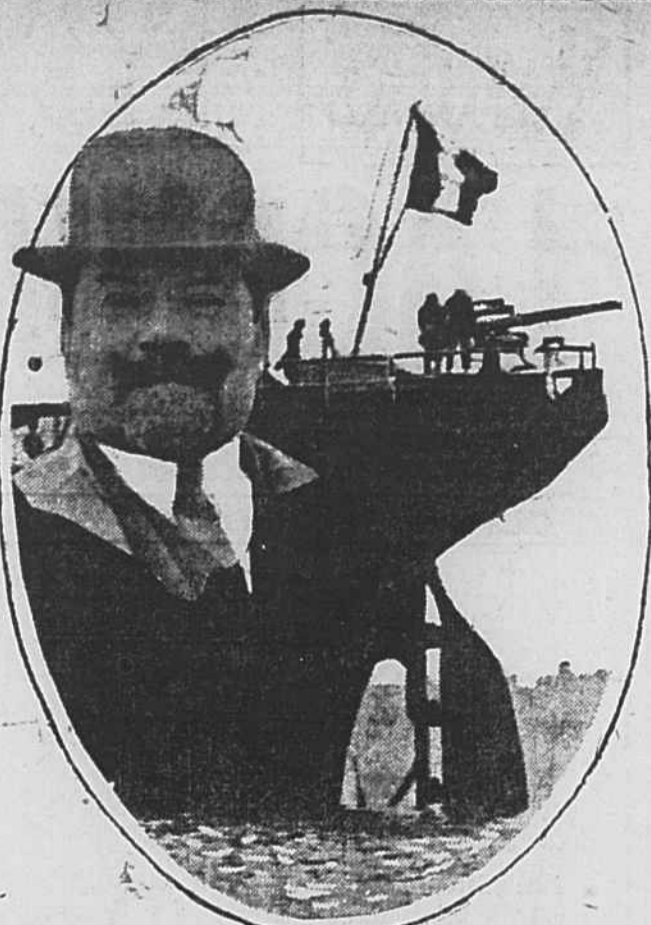

### Voting Series

Now that the interest and the voting has become so keen in the West Virginian's Golden Festival, it will be necessary that the candidates and their friends use a little care in depositing the coupons in the ballot box. Otherwise, it will be a physical impossibility for the department to make the count in time for the publication each day. As has already been explained, the votes are counted three times each week and the list published the following day. Therefore, the ballots that you cast each day will not appear to your credit on the list until the following publication day. In depositing the votes in the ballot box, be sure to see that they are neatly trimmed around the edges and pinned together. Be sure to see that the candidate's name is properly written on the top of the package. The Golden Festival Department receives thousands of votes every day with no name on. It is impossible for the manager to tell who these votes are intended for, consequently they must be consigned to the waste basket. In the future all votes not neatly trimmed and pinned together will be thrown out. Whenever it is possible for you to do so please pin or fasten each series together. When a series is voted, the manager issues a vote ballot for the extra 5,000 votes and returns it to the candidates.
