Emigration Canyon Electric Trolley Railroad over the trail of those who blazed the way for Western Civilization. This trail was first broken by the Indians in generations past; following them were the trappers who set their traps along the streams and in the glens; then came the ill-fated Donner party of '46, Brigham Young and his Pioneers in '47, the Gold-crazed California Forty-Niners, the famous Mormon Hand Cart Company in '56, and many other companies that have helped to make this trail one of the great landmarks of our country.
