A Continuing Scandal.

According to statements made in recent debate in the Senate it is the plan of the War Risk Bureau to add 3,000 more employees to its already unwieldy force of clerks and stenographers. Concerning the work of the Bureau at a time when it had 18,000 employees, Senator Pomerene, a Democrat, said that "some of the most wretched mistakes that it is possible for any human being to make came from this bureau," and Senator Smoot remarked that from his observations he did not believe that the girls employed in that bureau did in a seven-and-a-half hour day as much work as could be done much better by competent employees in an hour and a half. He based his opinion upon statements made to him by employees as well as upon the crowded conditions he saw while in the bureau offices. Both Senator Pomerene and Senator Smoot agreed that

there are large number of clerks employed there with nothing to do, some of them asking for transfers because they dislike to take the government's money without earning it.—Ex.

Japan Has Secret Shantung Treaties

Japan has secret treaties with Italy, France and Britain regarding the disposition of Shantung, Representative Kahn said in a statement a few days ago.

The treaties, Mr. Kahn charged, were entered into after this country broke diplomatic relations with Germany. He declares Japan should at once state definitely when she proposes to return Shantung to China. "If Viscount Ishii failed to inform

our government of the existence of these agreements, signed in the latter part of February and the early part of March, 1917, and after our country and China has severed diplomatic relations with the imperial government of Germany, was it not a questionable diplomatic practice on the part of Japan to have kept us in ignorance of the agreements with Great Britain, France, Russia and Italy?" said Mr. Kahn. Ought we to permit these secret agreements to overrule our obligations to China?

"With all these facts in mind, it is small wonder that the people of the United States, who have always retained a feeling of sincere friendliness to the people of China, and have also maintained a high regard for the

people of Japan, regret that the President of the United States and the premiers of Great Britain and France should have made their decision in favor of Japan in the Shantung matter.

"I do not believe there is any considerable percentage of the people of America who believe that the Shantung question was settled right at Paris.

"Japan, in my opinion, owes it to herself, to the United States and to the world generally to make a frank avowal of what she intends to do in Shantung."

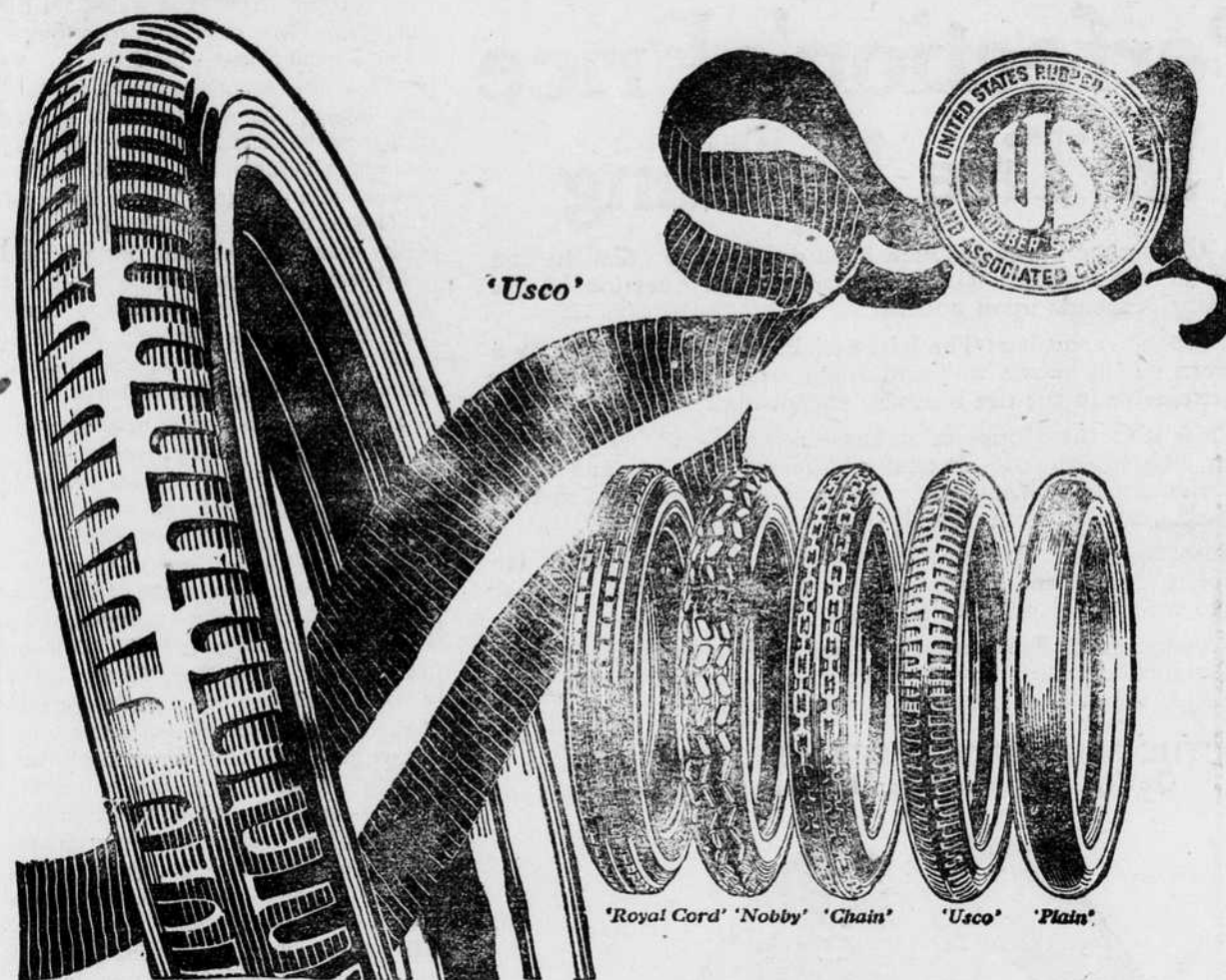
