Why salt should be regularly supplied to stock is thus put by a famous English authority: Because in the blood of animals there are six or seven times more sodium than potassium and the composition of the blood is consteat. To keep animals in good health a definite amount of common salt must be assimilated. The excess of potassium salts in vegetable foods causes by chemical exchange an abnormal loss of common sait.
This is proved by the fact that the

craving of an animal for common salt is most noticeable when the food contains a large proportion of potassium salts, such as wheat, barley, oats, potatoes, beans and peas. The addition of salt to animal food increases the appetite, promotes the repair of tissue by its searching diffusion through the body and stimulates the rapid using up of its waste products. Boussingault's experiments showed that salt increases muscular vigor and activity and improves the general appearance and condition.
