on events to note that it was not the liberal governor, Ellis Arnold, who unmasked the Klan, but rather the "reactionary" Herman Talmadge who made the act possible under his governorship.

In Fitzgerald Dick Kaminsky is a relative newcomer. He arrived in the South in the late twenties, and became a successful manufacturer of men's pants. He is married to the former Anne Cohen of Ashburn, Georgia, and together they have three stalwart sons. Anne is a schoolgirl friend of Georgia's First Lady.

The Kaminskys live in a tastefully decorated nine room home in Fitzgerald. Throughout the house family heirlooms from the old country are mixed with early American pieces in perfect harmony to add charm and color to the decor. Etchings and paintings executed by relatives are hung on the walls in the living room, den and dining room and reveals the talented family background and culture. A plaque or two placed in the den, honoring the master

of the house gives evidence to Kaminsky's standing in various organizations.

There is a plaque from the B'nai B'rith paying him tribute to dedicated service to that organization. Kaminsky was president of his local Ben Brith chapter for seven years, and followed this with two years service as State President. He also served on the District Executive for five years.

Currently Kaminsky is president of his congregation which he has served faithfully since he helped organize it in 1941. In its beginning he served as reader for the services.

Recently there was an invitation from President Eisenhower to represent the Georgia Citizen's Council at the National Safety Council meet in Washington. Kaminsky has served as Dean of the Georgia Teen Age Traffic Conference.

Today Kaminsky is concerned as are other peace-loving Georgia citizens with the forthcoming gubernatorial elections. Talmadge has refused a draft for the seat, and five of his followers face a race with Tom Linder, avowed Jew-hater and bigot. With the Talmadge-following split, Linder has a fair chance of making the grade to the Governor's mansion.
