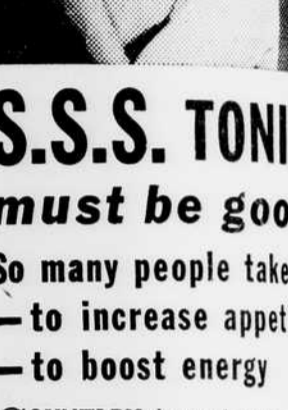

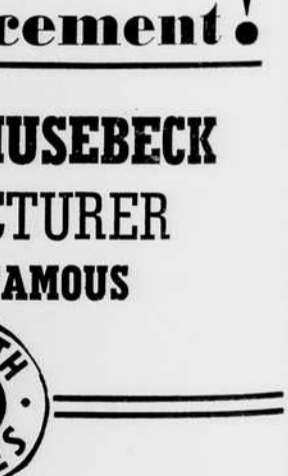
Sampson County Youth Is New 4-H Champion
