"WE, THE UNDERSIGNED CITIZENS AND RESIDENTS OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, respectfully urge the Peace Conference to recognize the aspirations and historic claims of the Jewish people with regard to Palestine, and to declare that in accordance with the British Government's declaration of November 2nd, 1917, endorsed by the Allied Governments and the President of the United States, there shall be established such political, administrative, and economic conditions in Palestine as will assure, under the trusteeship of Great Britain, acting on behalf of such League of Nations as may be formed, the development of Palestine into a Jewish Commonwealth, it being clearly understood that nothing shall be done which may prejudice the civil and religious rights of existing non-Jewish communities in Palestine, or the rights and political status enjoyed by Jews in any other country."
