President Roosevelt's Recommendation

That district attorneys be prohibited from engaging in the general practice of law. That United States commissioners be appointed by the governor instead of the district courts and that they receive a salary instead of being paid by the "free system" which the president says should be abolished. That delegate in congress be provided. That aid should be given in the building of wagon roads. That salmon hatcheries, lighthouses, and aids to navigation should be established and that fishing should be prohibited in certain streams. That a mounted constabulary be established to be commanded by the government. The president also says: "By judgment, it is especially important to aid in such manner as seems just and feasible in the construction of a trunk line of railways to connect the gulf of Alaska with the Yukon river through American territory. This would be most beneficial to the development and resources of the territory, and to the comfort and welfare of its people."
