

ALASKA CENTRAL OPPOSES GOVERNMENT AID

Ex-Senator Turner Says His Company Can Get Along Without a Subsidy and It Opposes Such For Other Lines

[Special Dispatch to Daily Alaskan.] Washington, March 13—The Alaska Central Railroad Company, which proposes to build a railway from Seward on the coast of Alaska to the Yukon river, does not want the United States government to help any Alaskan railroad with a subsidy. Ex-Senator George Turner, representing the Alaska Central, called on President Roosevelt today and made this request of him. He represented that the Alaska Central is prepared to build a railroad without any governmental aid.
