TELEGRAPHIC ITEMS

The attack on Port Arthur is expected to begin on June 15.
The Russian cruiser Bayan has been bottled up in Talienwan Bay.
Another army division has been sent from Japan to the seat of war.
The Republic of Panama has adopted the gold standard for its monetary system.
President Roosevelt delivered the memorial address at Gettysburg on May 30.
The Russians have four lines of defenses between Naushan and Port Arthur.
The British Tibetan expedition has been isolated and is in danger of destruction.
The Chinese war party is strenuously urging the Government to abandon neutrality.
Mrs. James A. Garfield, widow of the martyred president is seriously ill at Los Angeles.
It is reported that General Kuropatkin has begun an offensive campaign from Mukuen to the south.
There has been a five days battle northeast of Fengwangcheng, both sides suffering severely. Finally the Russians retired to Simatki.
The Illinois Republican Convention reconvened June 1, and are still deadlocked on choice for Governor.
Fire in the railway docks at Jersey City, May 30, caused a loss of \$5,000,000. Much coal was destroyed.
A serious battle has taken place near Manao, Hayti, in which the revolutionists were successful.
The Russians have hanged a number of Chinese caught signaling to the Japanese fleet near Vladivostok.
It is feared at St. Petersburg that the Baltic fleet will not be able to sail for the Far East before October.
The U. S. Government has refused to accept the terms offered by the kidnapers of Perdicaris at Morocco.
Chinese fugitives from Port Arthur report provisions scarce, with famine prices prevailing. The hospital are full.
The Presbyterian General Assembly at Buffalo has voted in favor of union with the Cumberland Presbyterians.
It is believed that the Japanese have mined Peter the Great Gulf, to prevent the egress of the Russian fleet from Vladivostok.

Robert McLane, mayor of Baltimore, committed suicide while insane by shooting himself, and will be succeeded by E. C. Timanus.
Charles Flint of New York has deposited \$5,000,000 with Rothschilds of Paris, as the value of the cruisers Esmareda and Chacabuco.
Ricarte, the rebel leader who has been endeavoring to excite the Filipinos to rebellion, has been captured and exiled to Guam.
It is rumored that a quarrel occurred between Alexieff and Kuropatkin at Mukden, and that the Czar is displeased with both of them.
The Japanese under General Oku occupied the port of Dainey, May 30, and found the docks, warehouses, and all other public buildings undamaged.
It is reported from Cheefoo that the land attack upon Port Arthur began on June 1, and that there was a battle within six miles of Port Arthur.
The Pacific Mail liner Korea bound to San Francisco, via Honolulu, has been placed in quarantine at Kobe, on account of a plague suspect on board.
An unknown robber entered the Auburn bank, California, presented a pistol, and grabbing the contents of the gold money tray, made good his escape.
The first great land battle between Japanese and Russian troops occurred at Kinchow on May 28, the Japanese defeating the Russians and capturing the town, with heavy loss on both sides.
