

MORNING SUMMARY.

The National Board of Steam Navigation will meet in New York to-day.

At a combination sale of Jersey cattle held yesterday in New York, the cow Jennie Page brought \$3,000.

A boiler in the pump factory at Belford, Ohio, burst yesterday afternoon, injuring six men, one of whom died soon after.

The new Park Theatre in Cleveland, Ohio, erected at a cost of \$300,000, and said to be fire-proof, was opened on Monday night.

The colored citizens of Washington, San Francisco and other cities held mass meetings to denounce the Civil Rights decision, on Monday night.

The Marquis of Lansdowne, the new Governor General of Canada, was sworn in yesterday morning at Quebec. There was no disturbance.

The Patent Office yesterday issued 413 patents, 21 designs, 28 trade marks and 31 labels, and made 4 releases. Foreigners received 29 of the patents.

The registration of voters in Brooklyn, New York, was completed on Monday night. The total number registered was 100,479, an increase of 1,957 since last year.

A reception was given by the New York Bar Association last night to Lord Chief Justice Colclough. There was a large representation of the bench and bar present.

The "Supreme Temple of Uniformed Patriarchs" will meet in special session at Milwaukee to-day, to adjust the trouble between the Circle and Grand Lodge of Odd Fellows.

At a meeting of manufacturers of knitted socks and their agents at Toronto, yesterday, it was decided that all the mills shall reduce their production over 40 per cent during the next six months.

The rear car of a passenger train on the Indianapolis, Bloomington and Western Railroad was yesterday afternoon, on Monday, near Rainwater, Indiana, and three of the passengers were severely hurt.

The annual session of the Universalist General Convention will begin to-day in Washington. Delegates will be present from 28 State Associations, and J. D. W. Joy, of Boston, will be chosen president.

The general manager of the Canadian Pacific railway, after a trip over the road, says the through line will be finished by October, 1895. Nine thousand men will work on the Lake Superior end all winter.

The condition of the iron and steel trade at Pittsburgh is reported to be good, with a prospect of work for several months to come. All the mills are in operation, and many of them have been running double time.

Rance Walton shot and fatally wounded R. J. Barkley in a saloon, Kansas, on Monday night. Barkley had been courting Walton's sister against the wishes of her family, and, it is alleged, had maligned her character.

The Chapter of the Franciscan Order in the United States began its triennial session yesterday in the Franciscan College at Trenton, N. J. Rev. Avelia Sabo presided. Officers for the next three years will be chosen to-day.

The Grand Commandery of Knights Templar of Illinois yesterday began its annual conference in Chicago. The reports of the Grand Recorder and Treasurer showed a balance of \$7,000 in the treasury and a membership of 6,000.

A passenger train and a pay car on the Arkansas branch of the Santa Fe Railroad collided near Winfield on Monday night. The fireman, James Dunlap, was dangerously injured. The collision is attributed to the error of a train dispatcher.

With a view to the making of a test case, the General Land Commissioner has refused to furnish an attorney with a copy of the report of a special agent of the Land Office concerning his client. An appeal will be taken to the Secretary of the Interior.

It is reported from Fort Bowie, Arizona, that 90 renegade Indians are returning to the San Carlos reservation. They will be met by a party of military with supplies. General Crook is reported, with his staff, "somewhere between San Carlos and the line."

Secretary Chandler yesterday telegraphed to Admiral Crosby, commanding the Asiatic fleet, to "proceed at once to the vicinity of Agincourt Island, near Formosa, and receive, if possible, the three American sailors belonging to the merchant vessel Spartans."

The two factions of the Democratic State Committee of Louisiana met yesterday in New Orleans, rank their differences and elected James R. Eastis chairman by a unanimous vote. It is understood the State Convention will be called to meet at Baton Rouge on December 15.

The charred remains of Charles Legg and his aunt, who perished in the fire at Annapolis on Monday, were found yesterday morning. It appeared, from their position, that Legg had reached his aunt in the third story, and was trying to get out with her when they were overcome.

The Treasury Department is considering a petition of American planters asking the duty to be charged on granulated rice and all forms of broken rice shall be the same as that imposed by law on whole rice. It is believed that before a decision is reached the importers will be heard.

All those injured in the railway disaster near Fort Edward, New York, are doing well and likely to recover. It is asserted that the bridge had been for some time repaired unsafe and that the master had been notified of the plying way of a stringer. The Company's officers say that "much heavier engines and trains passed over the bridge during the Lake George travel this summer."

A telegram from Cincinnati says that at Wampum, Penna., a piece of ground claimed by the Pittsburgh, Cleveland and Toledo Railroad Company and by the Pennsylvania Railroad Company "in possession of the former, were found yesterday morning by 20 men." The Pennsylvania Company yesterday sent 50 men to seize the property, "and skirmishing has been going on all day." Both sides sent for reinforcements.

A passenger train on the Louisville and Nashville railroad struck a broken rail yesterday morning, a few miles from East St. Louis. The engineer, feeling the shock, put on the brakes and all the cars passed over safely except the last two, which were wrecked. Thirty-seven passengers were injured, 10 severely, and one, J. B. Anthony, of Providence, Rhode Island, dangerously. Among the injured is Mr. Stern, clothing merchant, of Philadelphia, who suffered a severe scalp wound.

The three National Conventions of the Disciples of Christ, with 400 delegates, some from foreign countries, will meet in annual session in Cincinnati this week. Of these the Christian Women's Board of Missions began its sessions yesterday. The affairs of the Board are in a favorable condition, according to the showing in the annual report. Missions are sustained in India, Jamaica and the Western States and Territories in the United States. The disbursements for the year amounted to \$13,665. The Foreign Christian Missionary Society will begin its sessions to-day.

An address, signed by 83 leading Democrats of Massachusetts, the list being headed by J. O. Adams, Leverett Saltonstall, Richard Oliver, Clinton Viles, Francis W. Bird, George M. Stearns and N. S. Shaler, will be issued to the voters to-day, asking them to do all in their power to secure the defeat of Governor Butler at the next election. The Boston Herald reports that S. A. H. Abbott, who was nominated last Saturday ticket, declines to serve, and says he has no sympathy for Butler.

Ohio's Real Verdict.

(New York World.)

The official vote of Ohio makes the Democratic victory more sweeping and significant than the most sanguine have ventured to anticipate. The total vote cast in the State is 721,464. In 1890 the total vote on the State ticket was 718,180, or 3,274 votes less than this year. The total Presidential vote the same year was 724,077, or only 3,503 votes more than this year. In 1880 Garfield's majority over Hancock was 34,227. Governor Hoadly's majority over Foraker is 14,789—a difference in favor of the Democracy of 46,756.

Mr. Hoadly's total vote is 350,953. The Republican total vote is 347,064. Last year, when the Democratic plurality was 19,000, the total Republican vote was only 297,739. The Republican increase of nearly 50,000 votes show how ill founded are the claims of Republican "apathy" in the recent election.

The entire Prohibition and Greenback vote together are only 14,447 in the entire State. Thus the Democrats are only 1,919 votes short of a clear majority over all. We have not received the detailed Prohibition and Greenback vote, but the Greenback vote was probably between 4,000 and 5,000. Last year it was 5,355 and in 1880 it was 6,456. Thus the Democrats have a clear majority over both the Republican and Prohibition candidates, completely disproving the pretense that the Prohibition vote defeated Foraker.

In the Senate the Democrats have elected 23 Democrats against 11 Republicans and in the House 60 Representatives against 45 Republicans, giving a Democratic majority of 25 on joint ballot. So Charles Foster, United States Senator in expectancy, steps down and out.
