ARRIVAL OF THE DORIC FROM THE ORIENT.

Australia Taking on Freight—Mohican Gets Away—Large Shipment of Kona Coffee—Kilauea Hou Arrives.

The Kinau is expected next Tuesday.

Freight by the Doric amounted to 260 tons.

The Doric will sail at 7 o'clock Sunday morning.

There were no departures of inter island steamers today.

Bark Mohican left for San Francisco this morning with a full cargo of sugar.

German ship J. C. Glade is discharging the remainder of her coal cargo to make room for sugar.

Ship C. F. Sargent had to swing her bow outward to make room at the Pacific Mail wharf for the Doric.

The Ke Au Hou arrived this morning with 2626 bags Kilauea sugar. It is being put into the steamer Australia.

A large shipment of Kona coffee was brought down by the steamer Mauna Loa. It was consigned to local merchants.

The 3400 bags sugar brought by the steamer Mauna Loa are being stacked on the wharf and in the warehouse of the Oceanic company.

The Australia has begun taking in freight. She will take a full load of sugar. The inward freight cargo amounted to 1500 tons.

The brigantine Consuelo, Jacobsen master, sailed from Mahukona last Tuesday, bound for San Francisco. She took 5524 bags of sugar, valued at \$26,732.

A large lot of oranges from Kona were displayed for sale on the Inter Island wharf this morning. Chinese and Portuguese were the principal buyers.

Four masted schooner Robert Lewers is making but little headway in getting out her coal cargo. At the present rate of discharge it will be another week before she finishes.

The schooner Anna, W. C. Eeatt master, arrived at Mahukona on the 1st inst., sixteen days from San Francisco to Hawaiian Railroad Co. Cargo, 200 cases kerosene, 820 1/4 sacks flour, hay, grain and groceries.
