READING ROOM ASSOCIATION.

THIS INSTITUTION is located on  
the corner of Hotel and Alakea  
streets, directly opposite the building of  
the Y. M. C. A., and is open every day  
and evening, Sundays included.

The Reading Room is supplied with  
all the local journals, as well as nearly  
fifty of the leading foreign papers and  
magazines.

The Circulating Library consists of  
over 3,000 volumes, and is constantly  
increasing.

The Reference Library contains a  
valuable line of cyclopedias, dictio-  
naries, and works of a similar character.  
A handsome parlor is provided for  
conversation and games.

The Circulating Department is closed  
on Sundays.

Terms of membership: Signing the  
roll and paying the regular dues, fifty  
cents a month, quarterly in advance.

Strangers from foreign countries and  
visitors from other islands are welcome  
to the rooms at all times, but as the  
Association has no other regular means  
of support except the dues of members,  
it is expected that residents of Honolulu  
who desire to avail themselves of its  
privileges, and all who feel an interest  
in maintaining an institution of this  
kind in our community, will join the  
Association and pay the regular dues.
